Phase 1 – USFWI/QMI Triennial session (July 1-4) at Sun ‘n’ Sand Hotel, Mombasa, Kenya

Phase 2 – Tours of Lugulu, Kaimosi, African Ministries Office and Friends Theological College

(July 5-8). USFWI has supported projects in all three places in western Kenya. \$300

Phase 3 – General FUM Board Sessions – (July 9 – 11) near Bugoma, Kenya. You are welcome as

a spouse of a board member, or friend, or not even related. There will be things for you to do and

see as well. “This is a great opportunity to plan and worship alongside our brothers and sisters in Kenya.” \$300

Phase 4 – **Tours of Samburu/Turkana or a Safari (July 12-15)**. Arranged by Dick Mills, who grew up in Kenya as the son of a missionary. He knows the people and the culture. \$450 for Samburu/Turkana - \$450 for Safari.

Phase 2, 3 & 4 – **Work Projects Available (July 5 – 15)**. Kaimosi Hospital needs staff housing. Cost for food, lodging, transportation \$60/day.
