USFWI and FUM are planning tour opportunities for before and after the Triennial Conference. Visit the www.usfwi.org website for more information and for help with overseas travel plans.
 We recommend that all travelers from the US and other countries purchase a travel insurance policy to cover any accidents or medical issues. Overseas visitors should also be sure their passport does not expire within 6 months of travel and that they have all required immunizations.
 The hotel costs include three meals per day. The rates are per person and based on single, double or triple occupancy rooms. The additional K.Sh.500/- per day per person hotel conference fee is included in the rates quoted. Persons may have rooms at the conference rate for 2 days preceding and/or following the conference. Guests may accompany conference attendees but are to register and pay the same rates. There is no charge for children under the age of four. Children age 5-12 pay half of the adult rate if sharing a room with two adults or 75% if sharing the room with one adult or own room with other child. Youth above age 12 are considered adults.
